Day One

10:00—11:30 a.m. See first hand how pottery is made at **Hartstone Pottery Company**, home of America's finest handpainted and handcrafted gifts, tableware, and kitchenware. Take a factory tour and shop for beautifully decorated pottery items for your home.



11:45 a.m.—1:00 p.m. Learn about the craft beer-making process, enjoy great pizza and sample a variety of beers at **Weasel Boy Brewery**, Zanesville's first microbrewery.

1:30—3:00 p.m. Tour the largest contract embroidery company east of the Mississippi, **5 B's**. See computer driven embroidery machines at work with over 700 sewing heads. 5 B's embroiders for retailers such as Wal-Mart, JC Penney, Sears, and Gap to name a few.



3:30—5:00 p.m. Tour the **John and Annie Glenn Historic Site**, located in the boyhood home of John Glenn- Veteran, Astronaut and US Senator. You'll learn about 20th century American history through the lives of the Glenn's with a living history tour complete with actors in costume.

5:30—7:30 p.m. Enjoy a delicious buffet dinner complete with apple pie dessert at the **National Road-Zane Grey Museum** and then take a guided tour including a 136-foot diorama depicting the history of the National Road, America's first federally funded highway. Don't miss the original Conestoga wagon. Another part of the museum showcases western novelist and Zanesville native Zane Grey. You'll also view a wonderful collection of antique art pottery for which the area is famous.

Also learn about the history of the Longaberger Company, view educational displays and enjoy shopping at Longaberger Homestead. For lunch, have a family-style feast at Longaberger Restaurant.
