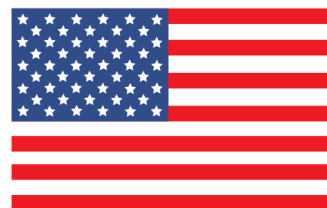

PARADE LIABILITY RELEASE, WAIVER, & COVENANT NOT TO SUE

Please Read Carefully

In consideration of being granted permission to participate in the Veterans Day Parade presented by the Rotary Clubs of Zanesville (the "Parade"), the undersigned ("Participant") acknowledges and agrees to the following:

1. Risks, Hazards, and Dangers. Participant is aware of and understands the inherent risks, hazards, and dangers associated with Parade participation, including but not limited to, animals, motor vehicles, floats, heavy equipment and machinery, firearms (for honorary salute), fireworks, projectiles, flags, banners, and balloons, loud noises, pedestrians and crowds (all ages), weather elements (wind, rain, hail, sleet, snow, lightning, etc.), and other threats to life, limb, and property, such as the possibility of a slip- and-fall, hazardous weather conditions, and physical exertion (frostbite, hypothermia, heat stroke, fainting, collapse, exhaustion, etc.).

2. Participant's Condition. Participant represents that he/she currently is, and will be on the day of the Parade, in good physical and mental condition to participate in the Parade. If Participant will be handling or operating any animal, motor vehicle, float, heavy equipment and machinery, firearms (if approved for honorary salute), fireworks, or other thing in the Parade, he/she has sufficient knowledge, training, and experience to do so safely without exposing others to unreasonable harm. If Participant is the driver of a motorized vehicle or float, Participant represents that he/she has a valid driver's license and has sufficient insurance on the vehicle or float. Smoking and alcohol consumption is NOT permitted.

3. Directions and Instructions. Participant agrees to follow all directions, instructions, and guidelines given by the Parade organizers, local officials, or law enforcement on the day of the Parade. Participant acknowledges he/she has reviewed the Parade route in advance and agrees to follow the Parade route, stay in line, and keep pace with the rest of the Parade.

4. Release, Waiver, and Covenant-Not-to-Sue. Participant releases, waives, discharges, and covenants not to sue the Rotary Club of Zanesville, the Rotary Club of Zanesville Daybreak, and the City of Zanesville (and their directors, officers, representatives, agents, elected officials, and employees) (collectively, "Releasees") from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, and damages of any type or nature, including injury to life, limb, or property, directly or indirectly related to or arising out of Participant's participation in the Parade, including pre-Parade staging, placement, and formation, the Parade itself, and post-Parade ceremonies.
