

# Free Admissions Tour

*There are so many things to see and do in Muskingum County, many of which are free of charge. This is an itinerary you can offer to groups that is very inexpensive. The only costs involved are lodging and meals. You'll hardly believe you can do so much for so little.*

## Day One

- 10:30 – 11:15 a.m. See how mouth-watering potato chips are made with over 50,000 pounds of potatoes per day at **Conn's Potato Chip Factory**. After the tour, treat yourself to the freshest chips around, right off the assembly line!
- 11:30 —11:45 a.m. Visit the **Muskingum County Welcome Center** where you'll be greeted by our friendly staff and provided with "goodie bags."
- 12:00—1:00 p.m. Relax and enjoy a delicious box lunch as you listen to the soothing sounds of the paddlewheel and cruise along the Muskingum River aboard the **Lorena Sternwheeler**. The charge for a ride and box lunch is an inexpensive \$15 per person.
- 1:15 – 1:45 p.m. Drive over the world-famous **Y Bridge** and take in the scenic view of the bridge at Putnam Overlook Park.
- 2:00 – 2:45 p.m. Stroll the gardens of **Mission Oaks**, a beautiful intercity woodland garden with majestic mature white oaks, a conifer garden, lovely gazebo, over 2,000 plants, 4 rain gardens, 2 waterfalls.
- 3:45 – 5:00 p.m. Choose from a variety of stores at **White Pillars Village**. Choices include White Pillars Christmas House, Zanesville Pottery, Colonial Cottage, Milk Thistle Farms, Mathews Antiques, White Pillars Antiques and Cottage Marketplace.
- 5:30 – 6:30 p.m. View impressive works of art at the **Zanesville Museum of Art** including American and European paintings, sculpture and historic and studio glass. Admission is free on Thursday evenings from 5-7:30 p.m.
- 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. Visit Artists in their studios and enjoy dinner in the ballroom of the **Masonic Temple** building. Zanesville is home to a growing **Artist Colony**, a community of living and working artists whose studios are open to the public. Hours and days open vary per studio.
- 9:15 p.m. Check into your host hotel.

## Day Two

- 9:00-9:30 a.m. Visit **Gale Garden**, a serene setting in the midst of the historic McIntire Terrace subdivision of Zanesville. Coffee or another beverage can be arranged for the group as they are walking around the garden.
- 10:00 – 11:30 a.m. Stroll the streets and continue shopping in the unique stores of the charming **Village of Dresden**.
- 11:30 – 1:00 p.m. Enjoy lunch at the **Warehouse Restaurant** in Dresden.
- 1:00 p.m. Depart for a safe trip home or continue on your journey. **The Historic Roscoe Village** in Coshocton County is not far and worth a stop!
